1.0 INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background

Jubb has been appointed to develop a Travel Plan for a residential development on land at Southfield Farm, Frome.

This Travel Plan should be read in conjunction with the Transport Assessment and Design and Access Statement that has been submitted as part of the planning application package for the proposed development.

1.2 Travel Plan Scope

This Travel Plan has been prepared in line with the Department for Transport guidance on residential travel plans.

In addition reference has been made to 'Somerset County County – Transport Policies – Travel Planning Guidance, November 2011'.

The developer is proposing to offer land to SCC for the provision of a primary school. SCC will produce its own School Travel Plan as details of teh school are unknown at this outline stage. The School Travel Plan will be submitted alongside the detailed planning application for the school and approved by Mendip District Council and Somerset County Council within 12 months of the opening of the school to enable input from all stakeholders i.e. pupils, parents, teachers, school governors. The Travel Plan will be secured by a Section 106 agreement.

1.3 This Document

The measures identified within this Travel Plan will assist in promoting healthier and more environmentally friendly travel to and from the proposed development in line with local, regional and national policies.

- Section 2 describes the site and the development proposal;
- Section 3 outlines the accessibility of the site and its location in relation to local services and facilities;
- Section 4 sets out the objectives and targets of the Travel Plan;
- Section 5 details the strategy for promoting the Travel Plan to ensure its success;
- Section 6 provides information on the sustainable transport measures which Hallam Land Management have committed to. This section also contains details of possible future measures which could be implemented, depending on the success of the Travel Plan;
- Section 7 outlines the monitoring and review programme that will ensure the Travel Plans continue to progress;
- · Section 8 contains a summary; and
- Section 9 sets out an Action Plan for the Travel Plan



2.0 SITE DESCRIPTION AND PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT

2.1 Site Location




Figure 2.1 - Site Location Plan

- 2.1.1 The site is located to the east of Frome. The site is bounded by an ASDA store to the north; a railway branch line and open fields to the west, a railway line and the A361 to the east and open fields to the south. The site location is shown in Figure 2.1
- 2.1.2 Frome town centre is located 1.5km 'as the crow-flies' to the north-west of the site.

2.2 Proposed Development

- 2.2.1 The development schedule of the proposed development is:
 - Up to 450 dwellings (market and affordable);
 - A community primary school
- 2.2.2 The application is for Outline planning permission and therefore at this stage there are no agreed layouts for within the site or details of numbers of the type / size of the dwellings to be provided.
- 2.2.3 Land will be offered to Somerset County Council to develop a community primary school which will be filled with pupils who will live in the proposed development.
- 2.2.4 The primary school will also provide community facilities for the residents within the proposed housing development through the hire of its halls, classrooms and sports pitch.
- 2.2.5 A Parameters Plan is shown in Figure 2.2.

2.2.6 Vehicle access will be taken from an extension of the existing unnamed road that serves the ASDA supermarket.

- 2.2.7 Footways will be constructed alongside the unnamed access road extending the existing provision into the site.




Figure 2.3 - NCN24 'Missing Link'

- 2.2.8 The development of this site enables part of the missing link to NCN 24 which runs from Frome to Longleat as shown in Figure 2.3.

- 2.2.9 The route as above is taken from 'Frome's Missing Links' website (http://www.fromesmissinglink.org.uk/longleatroute.aspx). However, with the introduction of the proposed housing development the route will run through the development using the network of proposed streets and cycleways. Currently Outline planning permission has been applied for and therefore the exact route of the proposed 'missing link' is unknown. When Reserved Matters and therefore detailed layout designs are submitted the route will be confirmed; the proposed route will be direct and use quiet streets or shared use cyclepaths with a minimum width of three metres.
- 2.2.10 SCC's Travel Plan Officer has requested that the developer considers providing a link to Feltham lane to the west of the A361 and a link to the railway station. The developer has considered this request but as 3rd party land is involved these aspirational links cannot be provided.



3.0 EXISTING SUSTAINABLE TRAVEL OPTIONS

3.1 The site is well located in terms of sustainable trabel options

3.2 Pedestrian and Cycle Facilities

- 3.2.1 The location of the site offers excellent footway and cycleway links to local services and facilities in Frome town centre.
- 3.2.2 The ASDA development implemented a high quality pedestrian /cycleway between the site access and the A362 / New Road junction, this section of the route is a 3m wide segregated route. There is also a pedestrian / cycle shared use route alongside the site access road between the A362 roundabout and the site boundary.
- 3.2.3 In addition there is an extensive network of Public Rights of Way (PRoW) that extend both into the urban area and out to the open countryside providing additional routes to local facilities and access to recreational routes. The PRoW network is shown in Figure 3.1.




Figure 3.2 - Cycle Network Plan (NCN 24)

3.2.4 There is an excellent and very pleasant off road pedestrian / cycle route (National Cycle Network 24(NCN 24)) alongside the River Frome from the New Road / A362 junction to the heart of the town centre. NCN24 is shown in **Figure 3.2**. If used as the route between the site boundary and the town centre a journey time of 7 minutes by bicycle and 20 minutes on foot is attained. This route varies in width but is generally a 4m wide shared use path which is well used as a leisure and commuting route by both pedestrians and cyclists. The route is well lit along its length and has a high quality tarmac surface. Photos of the route from the site to the town centre are attached in **Appendix A**.

- 3.2.5 A detailed audit of the walking and cycling network to key local facilities and services will be carried out prior to commencement of the development. The audit will identify any barriers and will be supported by photographs.
- 3.3 Distance to Local Services and Facilities




Figure 3.3 - 2 and 5 km Isochrones

3.3.1 It is widely accepted that walking and cycling are the most important modes of travel at the local level and offer the greatest potential to replace short car trips, particularly under 2 kilometres for walking and under 5 kilometres for cycling. Figure 3.3 shows the 2km and 5km walking and cycling isochrones.

- 3.3.2 The isochrones show in a basic format that the majority of Frome is within walking distance and all of Frome is within cycling distance of the site.
- 3.3.3 When assessing the accessibility of a site for pedestrians, and the proximity of local facilities, an average walking speed of 1.4 m/s can be assumed, which equates to approximately 400 metres in 5 minutes, or 3 mph. (Source: The Institution of Highway and Transportation (IHT) publication 'Guidelines for Providing

B14162/TP/28082014



Journeys on Foot, 2000'). An average cycling speed of 4.2 metres/second can be assumed when assessing accessibility.

- 3.3.4 Key local facilities and services within a 2km radius of the site have been interrogated using the Promap database. The report generates the nearest 500 facilities and services to the site. Whilst Promap measures distances as the crow flies the locations identified have been used and then the distance measured using actual walking / cycling distances from the centre of the site.
- 3.3.5 The distance from entry to the site to the nearest key facilities and services are shown in **Table 3.1** below along with the time taken to travel on foot and by bicycle. The dwellings in the south-east corner of the site are a further 460 metres from the point that distances have been calculated from. The full Promap report is attached in **Appendix B**.

3.3.6 The results show that there are a wide range of local services and facilities within walking and cycling distance of the development site ensuring that future residents are able to undertake their everyday requirements by sustainable modes of transport.



3.4 Public Transport

3.4.1 Bus

3.4.2 The nearest bus stop to the development is located on Warminster Road outside of the ASDA store, which is 405 metres from the site. This bus stop gives access to Service 53 which travels between Frome, ASDA and Warminster. The bus stops consist of bus flags attached to lamp columns. The service, its frequency and earliest and latest buses are shown in Table 3.2.

- 3.4.3 Service 53 enables users to commute to their places of work in Frome and Warminster.
- 3.4.4 Service 31, which operates one outbound and one inbound service a day, provides students to travel to Sexeys and Bruton schools by public transport. This service stops at Frome railway station, which is located 1025 metres from the site.
- 3.4.5 Bus timetables are attached in Appendix C.
- 3.4.6 National Express run coach service 402 daily from Frome to Victoria Station, London stopping at Marlborough, Newbury and Heathrow. The outbound service leaves at 07:05 arriving at 11:15 and the inbound service leaves at 18:00 arriving at 21:40.
- 3.4.7 Rail
- 3.4.8 Frome railway station is located approximately 1025 walk distance from the site and offers a wide range of locations including direct trains to Bristol and Bath as well as direct trains to London Paddington at peak times. All services are provided by First Great Western.
- 3.4.9 The station provides secure covered parking for ten bicycles.
- 3.4.10 The details the peak hour rail services, which enable commuter journeys, are summarised in **Table 3.3**.

3.5 Summary

- 3.5.1 The site is accessible by all modes of travel providing future residents with a choice of transport modes when travelling to and from the site.
- 3.5.2 The site is located close to a number of key local services and facilities and within walking distance of Frome's railway station and town centre.



4.0 OBJECTIVES AND TARGETS

4.1 Objectives

- 4.1.1 The main objectives of this Travel Plan are to:
 - Encourage sustainable travel modes for travel to/from the site;
 - Enable access to a full range of facilities for work, education, health, leisure, recreation and shopping; and
 - Promote healthy lifestyles for the residents of the development

4.2 Targets

- 4.2.1 As end users and their existing travel habits are not known the 2011 'Journey to Work' Census Data has been interrogated to inform existing modal splits. The output from the Office of National Statistics is attached in Appendix D.
- 4.2.2 Using the 'Frome Keyford' ward as an origin the journey to work data contained within the 2011 Census has been interrogated to indicate the expected modal split for the development site and is shown in **Table 4.1**. This data is based on the nearest ward and is representative of modal choice that the development will generate without a Travel Plan.

4.2.3 From these figures modal splits have been derived to calculate the percentage of residents who will occupy a car on their own (SOV – single occupancy vehicle) and the percentage of residents who will car share as shown in **Table 4.2**.

4.2.4 The SOV of 55.3% is less than the SOV for Mendip District (60.3%) and more than the SOV for England (52.0%).



- 4.2.5 Based on these figures it is proposed that the initial main target of the Travel Plan will be to reduce single occupancy car journeys over the initial 5 year period by 5% to 50.3%.
- 4.2.6 The submitted Transport Assessment identified the vehicle trip rates for 'Privately Owned Houses' and 'Houses for Rent'. These trip rates and the associated vehicle trips for 450 dwellings on a 70:30 private:social ratio are provided below in Tables 4.3, 4.4 and 4.5.

4.2.7 As can be seen from the trip generation, privately owned dwellings generally generate more vehicle trips than social housing dwellings. The salaries of tenants of social housing tend to be lower and are more reliant on walking, cycling and public transport.

5.0 TRAVEL PLAN STRATEGY


5.1 Management

- 5.1.1 The appointment of a Travel Plan Coordinator (TPC) is one of the most important aspects of any Travel Plan.
- 5.1.2 A TPC will be appointed to co-ordinate the Travel Plan and the measures which are incorporated into it during the construction period and will be in post for a period of 5 years following 80 percent occupation of the development.
- 5.1.3 The TPC will be responsible for implementing the Travel Plan and reporting against the agreed Travel Plan Targets and Action Plan entered onto Somerset County Council's iOnTRAVEL website. The name and contact details of the TPC will be provided to SCC.
- 5.1.4 The Travel Plan will be registered on iOnTRAVEL prior to approval, the iOnTRAVEL system will be used for the duration of the Travel Plan from registration and approval through to implementation and monitoring, the Travel Plan will not be approved until the agreed Travel Plan document has been uploaded on the system along with the relevant Site Synopsis, Targets and Action Plan data.
- 5.1.5 The TPC will be responsible for all aspects of the Travel Plan. His or her primary functions will be as follows:
 - Registration of the Travel Plan on <u>www.iontravel.co.uk</u> including payment of the agreed fee;
 - Implementation of the Travel Plan in accordance with the agreed Action Plan;
 - Reporting progress of the Travel Plan against the Travel Plan Targets and Action Plan via www.iontravel.co.uk;
 - Liaison with the local planning and highway authorities;
 - · Organisation of travel surveys;
 - Promotion of sustainable transport measures to residents this will take place



from occupation of the first dwelling and will be repeated annually;

- · Organisation of car sharing schemes;
- Maintenance of all necessary systems, data and paperwork, such as tenant contact details and records of the distribution of Welcome Packs;
- Liaison with local schools and businesses who have Travel Plans to share ideas, generate economies of scale and reduce costs;
- Updating the site's Travel Plan website and notice boards.
- 5.1.6 Increasing the travel awareness of residents so that they can make informed travel choices is seen as a key role of the TPC.
- 5.1.7 The TPC will be given sufficient time and resources to effectively undertake their duties and implement the Travel Plan. Additionally, the developer commits to ensuring the TPC will be provided with the required training for example that provided by ACT Travelwise.
- 5.1.8 The TPC will work closely with Travel Plan Officers at SCC and seek to promote any transport initiatives the council may have.
- 5.1.9 The developer will pay SCC £3000 + VAT to monitor the progress of the TP over the life of the development.
- 5.2 Marketing and Consultation
- 5.2.1 Residential
- 5.2.2 All residents will be made aware of the existence of the Travel Plan on the occupation of their residence on the site. The details of the Travel Plan, its objectives in enhancing the environment, and the role of individuals in achieving these objectives will be explained.
- 5.2.3 A Welcome Pack will be provided. This will contain Travel Plan and sustainable transport information and other relevant transport information including:
 - A summarised version of the Travel Plan Strategy document, that sets out the purpose and benefits etc;
 - A multi-modal leaflet to include walking, cycling and public transport routes and information;
 - A plan showing the location of local facilities and services;
 - Contact numbers and web details for First, First Great Western, Traveline South West:
 - Car Share Scheme information including www.carsharesomerset.com
 - Local taxi company details;
 - The contact details of local and national cycling organisations, such as SUSTRANS;



- Information on working from home;
- Web details for any community travel sites and community forum sites;
- · Contact details of the site TPC and SCC's TPC and
- 5.2.4 The Welcome Pack and its final content will be agreed with SCC's Travel Plan Officer.
- 5.2.5 A Travel Plan safeguard sum of a maximum of £112,500 will be provided to Somerset County Council to be used should the single occupancy vehicle targets be missed. A formula-based target will be used to draw down the safeguard funding. Somerset County Council will determine how much money is to be drawn down on an annual basis according to this formula:

T = target split (SOV)

A = actual modal split (SOV) (average of survey and count data)

H = 100% modal split (SOV)

M = midpoint between T and H

E = exceedence

S = total safeguard sum (£)

Safeguard sum to be drawn down = $[(A-T)/(H-T)] \times (S \times 2)$

5.2.6 A Travel Plan Management Budget of £15,000 will be made available to the TPC for promotional activity.



6.0 SUSTAINABLE TRANSPORT MEASURES

6.1 This section details the measures which the developer has committed to in an effort to ensure the success of the Travel Plan.

6.2 On-site

- 6.2.1 The developer has committed to the following measures to ensure travel to and from the site is as sustainable as possible and that the Travel Plan is a success. These measures will be the responsibility of the current developer or any future developers.
- 6.2.2 A pedestrian link will be provided to enable residents access to and from the existing shared pedestrian / cycle path on the ASDA Spine Road; cyclists will be accommodated on-road. A plan showing this route is attached in **Appendix E**.
- 6.2.3 In terms of the layout and design of the site a network of high quality pedestrian and cycle routes within the site will offer direct, safe and convenient access around the site by foot and bicycle.
- 6.2.4 This network of routes will provide part of the missing link to NCN24 which runs from Frome to Longleat i.e. the part of the missing link that falls within the development site.
- 6.2.5 Pedestrian and cycling signage will be provided within the site.
- 6.2.6 The design of the estate roads will be in accordance with Manual for Streets and other relevant guidance so that the road system is not the dominant feature within the new community. By undertaking this approach it is hoped that car speeds will be kept low and hence walking and cycling will be an attractive mode of transport.
- 6.2.7 To enable bus services to access the site a bus stop will be provided within the site and will provide a bus shelter, timetable display and bus boarders.
- 6.2.8 A travel website will also be maintained by the TPC providing travel information for site users. The website will contain public transport information, pedestrian and cycle route information, as well as details of any car share scheme and other sustainable travel initiatives. The website will be in operation prior to the occupation of the first dwelling.
- 6.2.9 Two Travel Plan Notice boards, with minimum dimension of 1m x 2m, will be installed in prominent positions to be agreed with the Council. Bus timetables, pedestrian and cycle route information, details of car free days etc. will be displayed. These will be updated on a regular basis by the TPC.



- 6.2.10 Residential developers will consider the provision of home office space within residential dwellings. Provision of home office space would allow future residents to work from home, minimising the number of journeys made to and from the site as the need to commute on a daily basis is removed.
- 6.2.11 Due to Outline planning permission being sought the number of different types of houses is unknown at this stage and therefore the developer commits to provide vehicle, cycle and motorcycle parking in accordance with the Council's parking standards as shown below in **Table 6.1**.

Table 6.1 Somerset County Council Parking Strategy

A minimum of 1 space per bedroom.

NOTE A — The car parking standards set out here are optimum standards; the level of parking they specify should be provided unless specific local circumstances can justify deviating from them. Developments in more sustainable locations that are well served by public transport or have good walking and cycling links may be considered appropriate for lower levels of car parking provision. Proposals for provision above or below this standard must be supported by evidence detailing the local circumstances that justify the deviation and must be included in the developer's Travel Plan.

NOTE B - Car parking standards include any garages or car ports provided.



- 6.2.12 Reserved Matters applications will indicate the location of cycle parking spaces i.e. for individual dwellings enlarged garages or sheds with suitable locking points will be used, for apartments shared enclosed structures with suitable locking points will be used and for visitors 'Sheffield' type stand will be provided within the public highway. Dimensions / space for cycle parking will be in accordance with Somerset County Council's Parking standards.
- 6.2.13 The Reserved Matters applications will also detail the size of garages; garages will be provided in accordance with Somerset Council's Parking standards.
- 6.2.14 All dwellings will be provided with an outside plug socket so that electric vehicles can be charged.

6.3 Smarter Choices

- 6.3.1 A Welcome Pack will be distributed to each household upon occupation.
- 6.3.2 A travel website will be maintained by the TPC providing travel information for site users. The website will contain public transport information, pedestrian and cycle route information, as well as details of car share websites and other sustainable initiatives.
- 6.3.3 Travel Vouchers will be provided for each dwelling for up to three tenures for 5 years following first occupation of each unit in line with **Table 6.2** below.

- 6.3.4 The TPC will implement walking and cycling Budi schemes.
- 6.3.5 The TPC will investigate whether any local bike shops offer a discount for the purchase of bicycles and equipment.
- 6.3.6 The TPC will encourage residents to join local and national car share websites through promotional materials.
- 6.3.7 The TPC will advertise, promote and co-ordinate events such as Walk/Cycle to Work Days/Weeks.



- 6.3.8 The TPC will organise bicycle maintenance sessions.
- 6.3.9 Local bus companies may wish to offer subsidised public transport tickets or a free weekly trial pass to try and encourage the residents to use public transport. The TPC will investigate with local bus companies the possibility of opportunities.
- 6.3.10 Bus boarders, timetables and appropriate bus shelters will be provided at the existing bus stops on A362 outside of the ASDA store to encourage public transport usage.



7.0 MONITORING AND REVIEW

7.1 Monitoring

- 7.1.1 The monitoring period will extend from the first occupation to a period of five years following 80 percent occupation of the development.
- 7.1.2 Travel plan surveys will be undertaken one year after 80% occupation is received and annually thereafter for 5 years. These surveys will then be undertaken annually following the first baseline survey. These surveys will utilise SCC's standard template and a 40 percent response rate will be required. The survey responses will be entered on to iOnTRAVEL by the TPC within three months of the survey date.
- 7.1.3 A spreadsheet will be kept and submitted to the Council recording when households receive their Travel Plan Welcome Pack
- 7.1.4 A permanent Automatic Traffic Counter will be installed at the site entrance.

7.2 Review

- 7.2.1 An annual review of targets and measures will be undertaken. The monitoring surveys will show whether targets are being met and whether the measures implemented are having the desired effect on travel patterns.
- 7.2.2 The TPC will undertake a full and comprehensive review of the Travel Plan annually. This review will involve completely updating the Travel Plan document to take into account changes to transport availability, changes in travel patterns, changes in resident / employee numbers and measures.
- 7.2.3 Any on-going monitoring of measure uptake will be included within the review.
- 7.2.4 The monitoring programme will help to identify what is causing the target to not be met. Rectifying problems could involve implementing more or different measures. The monitoring will be undertaken in-house by the TPC using an approved questionnaire.

7.3 Reporting

- 7.3.1 The TPC will compile an annual Monitoring Report outlining the results of the monitoring survey and review. The report will also incorporate the results of on-going monitoring throughout the preceding period. The report will be submitted on iOnTRAVEL.
- 7.3.2 The monitoring report will include the following aspects:
 - Site Name and Address;
 - A summary of the Travel Plan



- · How and when monitoring information was gathered;
- · Whether travel patterns are meeting objectives and targets; and
- · Proposals to further develop the Travel Plan
- 7.3.3 Reviews of the TP may take place annually which may lead to measures being changed in order to deliver the set targets. However, the original targets set will remain. At the end of the 5 year monitoring period a fresh, updated TP will be prepared and approved.



8.0 SUMMARY

- 8.1 To support travel to and from the site HLM have committed to:
 - The provision of a Welcome pack for each household;
 - Pedestrian / cycle link onto the existing ASDA Spine Road pedestrian / cycle link;
 - The provision of part of the NCN24 missing link within the boundary of the site;
 - The provision of suitable car, cycle and motorcycle parking;
 - Provision of bus boarders, timetables and appropriate bus shelters will be provided at the existing bus shelters on A362 outside of the ASDA store;
 - The provision of a bus stop including bus shelter, timetable display and bus boarders within the site;
 - The provision of a Travel Plan website and two notice boards;
 - Travel Plan vouchers for each dwelling for one tenure;
 - · A permanent ATC located at the site entrance;
 - · The funding of the TPC;
 - A sustainable design of the site, in accordance with Manual for Streets, which
 places walking and cycling at the top of the transport hierarchy.
 - A comprehensive monitoring program has been drawn up to ensure the success of the Travel Plan. Action Plan
 - A Travel Plan Safeguard Sum of £112,500.



- 2.1 The headings in this Schedule are for reference only. They are not to be used to interpret the text beneath.
- 2.2 References to the parties and paragraphs mean those in this Schedule.
- 2.3 References to persons include bodies corporate, unincorporated associations and partnerships, in each case whether or not they have a separate legal identity.
- 2.4 Unless the context specifically requires otherwise:
 - 2.4.1 words relating to one gender are treated as meaning any gender;
 - 2.4.2 words relating to individuals are treated as also meaning corporations and vice versa;
 - 2.4.3 words in the singular are treated as also meaning the plural and vice versa; and
 - 2.4.4 words relating to the whole are treated as including any part of the whole.
- 2.5 All agreements and obligations by a party in this transfer (whether or not expressed as covenants) are to be read as covenants by that party.
- 2.6 If a condition or covenant in this transfer requires a

party not to do something, it is a breach of the condition or covenant to allow somebody else to do it.

- 2.7 References to statutory provisions, acts or EC Directives include (except where expressly stated to the contrary) references to:
 - 2.7.1 any changes to them, including any extension, consolidation, replacement or re-enactment (before or after the date of this transfer);
 - 2.7.2 any previous statutory provisions, acts or EC Directives that they have replaced or changed; and

- 2.10 This transfer does not confer on any person or party (except the parties to it) rights under the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999.
- 2.11 References to rights of access to the Property by the Transferor are extended to anybody authorised by the Transferor.
- 2.12 The words "include" and "including" are deemed to be followed by the words "but not limited to".
- 2.13 Reference to the 'Transferor' and the 'Transferee' shall include their respective successors in title.

3 Transfer of Property

- 3.1 The Exceptions and Reservations are excepted from this transfer and reserved to the Transferor for the benefit of the Retained Land.
- 3.2 The Property is transferred subject to and (where appropriate) with the benefit of the Existing Matters.
- 3.3 (Subject to paragraph 3.4 as relevant) The Property is transferred together with the following rights:
 - 3.3.1 to the free and uninterrupted passage and transmission of any matter whether solid, liquid or gas (including air, smoke, steam, water, sewage and waste) or electricity, light, power, sound, communications, impulses, information, data or other energy, wave or force even if incorporeal or intangible, to and from the Property by any Conduits now or

within eighty years of the date of this transfer on, under or through the Retained Land so far as the same are intended to be adopted by the local or other relevant authority or body;

- 3.3.2 Of entry onto the unbuilt parts of the Retained Land (but not onto any curtilage of any residential dwelling) for the purposes of repairing and renewing any such Conduits serving the Property; and
- 3.3.3 To lay, connect into, alter, enlarge or replace any such Conduits on under or through the Retained Land in so far as reasonably necessary to service the Property for use as a school.
- 3.3.4 To escape in the case of fire or other emergency and also (upon reasonable notice to the Transferor) for the purposes of fire or other emergency drill practice over such unbuilt parts of the Retained Land which do not comprise the curtilage of any residential dwelling on the Retained Land as are reasonably necessary for that purpose (and insofar as such emergency drill assembly cannot be accommodated on the Property).
- 3.3.5 To build on and develop a school at the Property including to alter any school buildings from time to time erected on the Property.
- 3.3.6 to pass and repass at all times and for all purposes connected with access to and egress from the Property over and along the Estate Roads from time to time until (if ever) the same has been adopted by the local authority as maintainable by such authority.
- 3.3.7 The right of support and shelter for the Property from the Retained Land.
- 3.4 Before exercising the rights mentioned in paragraphs 3.3.1 to 3.3.3 (inclusive), the Transferee will give the Transferor reasonable written notice (except in emergency). In exercising such rights the Transferee will:
 - 3.4.1 cause as little inconvenience and damage to the Retained Land and the tenants and occupiers of the Retained Land as is reasonably practicable and make good to the reasonable satisfaction of the Transferor any damage caused to the Retained Land by the exercise of those rights as soon as reasonably practicable;
 - 3.4.2 comply with all statutory requirements; and
 - 3.4.3 ensure that any connections new or

replacement Conduits are only laid or installed in unbuilt parts of the Retained Land (but not within the curtilage of any residential dwelling) in positions approved by the Transferor (acting reasonably).

4 Indemnity covenant

For the sole purpose of giving the Transferor a complete indemnity, the Transferee covenants with the Transferor that the Transferee and the persons deriving title under the Transferee will:

- 4.1 at all times from the date of this transfer perform and observe the Existing Matters so far as:
 - 4.1.1 they relate to the Property and are capable of being enforced; and
 - 4.1.2 any breach of them could expose the Transferor to liability;
- 4.2 indemnify and keep indemnified the Transferor against all losses, actions, claims, demands, expenses, proceedings and liability in any way relating to any failure to observe and perform the matters set out in paragraph 4.1 from the date of this transfer.

5 Exceptions and Reservations

- 5.1 There are excepted and reserved to the Transferor and the occupiers for the time being of the Retained Land and each and every part of it and all other persons authorised by it or them (including without limitation the relevant authorities) for all purposes connected with the present and future use of the Retained Land and each and every part of it to the intent that they shall be forever attached to the Retained Land and each and every part of it:
 - 5.1.1 The right to the free and uninterrupted passage and transmission of any matter whether solid, liquid or gas (including air, smoke, steam, water, sewage and waste) or electricity, light, power, sound, communications, impulses, information, data or other energy, wave or force even if incorporeal or intangible, to and from the Retained Land by any Conduits now or within eighty years of the date of this transfer on, under or through the Property.
 - 5.1.2 The right of support and shelter for the Retained Land from the Property.
- 5.2 Before exercising the rights mentioned in paragraph 5.1, the Transferor will give the Transferee reasonable written notice (except in emergency). In exercising such rights, the Transferor will:
 - 5.2.1 cause as little inconvenience and damage to

- 5.2.2 make good to the reasonable satisfaction of the Transferee any damage caused to the Property by the exercise of those rights as soon as reasonably practicable; and
- 5.2.3 comply with the Transferee's reasonable requirements for the safety and protection of pupils.

6 Existing Matters

- 6.1 All easements, quasi-easements and any incidents of tenure.
- 6.2 All rights, exceptions, reservations, covenants, conditions and matters whatsoever contained in the Property and Charges Registers of the Title Numbers insofar as they relate to the Property and are capable of being enforced.
- 6.3 All local land charges (whether registered or not at the date of this agreement) and all matters capable of registration as local land charges.
- 6.4 All notices, demands, proposals and requirements served, made or to be made by any local or other public authority (whether before or after the date of this agreement).
- 6.5 All matters referred to in Schedules 1 and 3 of the Land Registration Act 2002 and any matters which were overriding interests as defined in section 70(1) Land Registration Act 1925 and which continue in effect under Schedule 12 Land Registration Act 2002.
- 6.6 All rights of way, water, light, air and other rights, easements, quasi-easements, liabilities and public rights (including the public rights of navigation and fishing) whatsoever.

7 Restrictive Covenants

- 7.1 The Transferee covenants with the Transferor to observe and perform the Restrictive Covenants with the intention that:
 - 7.1.1 the burden of the Restrictive Covenants will run with and bind each and every part of the Property;
 - 7.1.2 save as contained in clause 7.2.1 the benefit of the Restrictive Covenants will be annexed to and run with the Retained Land; and
 - 7.1.3 the benefit of the covenant in clause 7.2.1 shall only be annexed to and run with the Retained Land and benefit any successor in title where the benefit of such covenant is expressly assigned to a successor and

expressed to benefit the Retained Land or (as the case may be) the part of the Retained Land transferred otherwise.

7.2 The Restrictive Covenants are:

- 7.2.1 not to do on the Property anything which in the Transferor's opinion (acting reasonably) may be or become a public or private nuisance or an annoyance, grievance or inconvenience to the Transferor or the tenants or occupiers of the Retained Land, or which may lessen the value of the Retained Land PROVIDED THAT reasonable and proper use as a school shall not be a breach of this covenant; and
- 7.2.2 not to use the Property except as a school (together with ancillary uses consistent with principal use as a school) PROVIDED THAT leaving the Property unused pending construction of a school shall not be a breach of this clause.

8 Declarations

- 8.1 The Transferee will not by virtue of this transfer acquire in respect of the Property any right of light or air or any other easement, liberty or privilege over or in respect of the Retained Land.
- 8.2 The Transferor and their grantees and tenants may erect anything on the Retained Land and alter or add to or use it or any existing thing on the Retained Land in such a manner as they think fit, even though this may affect the access and use of light or air now or afterwards enjoyed by the Transferee. Such access and use of light or air is only enjoyed by the Transferee subject to this paragraph 8.

9 Re-transfer

9.1 In this clause 9:

Deed of Covenant: a deed of covenant with the Transferor containing covenants in favour of the Transferor in the same terms as those given by the Transferee in this Transfer with such minor modifications proposed by the Transferor as the Transferor may agree (acting reasonably);

Disposal: a disposition within the meaning of section 205 of the Law of Property Act 1925 of the whole or any part or parts of the Property.

9.2 If on or before the earlier of (a) the date of expiry of two (2) years from the date of grant of full planning permission or reserved matters approval for a first school to be built on the Property and (b) the date of expiry of five (5) years after the date of this Transfer the Transferee has not let a building contract for construction of a first school on the Property the Transferee will within one calendar month of that date give notice in writing ("Trigger Notice") to the Transferor and if so requested by the Transferor in

writing shall immediately transfer the Property back to the Transferor for the consideration of £1 (one pound) free from litter, debris and/or building materials and otherwise free from encumbrances other than those binding the Property at the date of this Transfer (excluding the Section 106 Agreement made between (1) Mendip District Council (2) the Transferee (3) Bernard Charles Hann and Pauline Anne Hann (4) Beryl Cunningham Cross, Belinda Jayne Williams, Robert Bruce Cross and Allan Francis Cross and (5) Hallam Land Management Limited) and the Transferor shall be free to deal with the Property as they see fit free from the constraints of this Transfer PROVIDED THAT if the Transferee does not serve such Trigger Notice then at any time after the expiry of such one (1) calendar month period the Transferor shall be entitled to serve its own notice in writing on the Transferee requiring a transfer of the Property to it and upon service of such notice in writing a Trigger Notice shall be deemed to have been served at the date of service of such notice by the Transferor.

9.3 The Transferee shall apply to enter the following restriction against the Transferee's title to the Property at the Land Registry at the cost of the Transferee on the registration of this Transfer in priority to any charge or other encumbrance and shall provide the Transferor with a copy of the title without delay following registration:

"No disposition of the registered estate by the proprietor of the registered estate, or by the proprietor of any registered charge, not being a charge registered before the entry of this restriction, is to be registered without a written consent signed by a solicitor that the provisions of clause 9.4 of the Transfer dated [] have been complied with or no longer apply"

9.4 The Transferee shall not make any Disposal at any time without first procuring that the person to whom the Disposal is being made has executed a Deed of Covenant.

The transferor must execute this transfer as a deed using the space opposite. If there is more than one transferor, all must execute. Forms of execution are given in Schedule 9 to the Land Registration Rules 2003. If the transfer contains transferee's covenants or declarations or contains an application by the transferee (such as for a restriction), it must also be executed by the transferee.
